#### CONDITIONS

Pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A:5A-10 and 11 of the Local Authorities Fiscal Control Law and N.J.A.C. 5:31-2.1 et seq., each Authority in the State of New Jersey is required to submit a budget for each fiscal year to the Director of the Division of Local Government Services for review and approval. In accordance with these statutory and regulatory requirements, the Camden County Municipal Utilities Authority submitted its introduced budget for the fiscal year ending December 31, 2013 to the Director for review and approval. During the review of the 2013 budget for the Authority, the Sewer Rate Resolution will be adopted on December 17, 2012.

Until that Resolution is approved by the CCMUA, the 2013 budget should not be adopted by the Authority, and cannot be unconditionally approved by the Director.

Since the introduced budget is required to be submitted to the Division at least 60 days prior to the end of the current fiscal year, it has been decided that until the Resolution is approved, it is in the best interests of the Division and the Authority that the introduced budget be submitted on a timely basis, in order that all other items in the budget can be reviewed.

When the Sewer Rate Resolution is adopted, the Authority should proceed as follows:

Upon the Sewer Rate Resolution being adopted by CCMUA, the Authority may adopt the budget and submit two copies, including pages 7 and 8 (which refer to the adoption), to the Division for the Director's approval.



WHEREAS, the Annual Budget and Capital Budget for the Camden County MUA for the fiscal year beginning, 1/1/2013 and ending, 12/31/2013 has been presented before the governing body of the Camden County MUA at its open public meeting of October 15, 2012; and

WHEREAS, the Annual Budget as introduced reflects Total Revenues of \$ 98,608,929, Total Appropriations, including any Accumulated Deficit if any, of \$ 101,744,101 and Total Unrestricted Net Assets utilized of \$3,135,172; and

WHEREAS, the Capital Budget as introduced reflects Total Capital Appropriations of \$30,800,000.00 and Total Unrestricted Net Assets planned to be utilized as funding thereof, of \$850,000.00; and

WHEREAS, the schedule of rates, fees and other charges in effect will produce sufficient revenues, together with all other anticipated revenues to satisfy all obligations to the holders of bonds of the Authority, to meet operating expenses, capital outlays, debt service requirements, and to provide for such reserves, all as may be required by law, regulation or terms of contracts and agreements; and

WHEREAS, the Capital Budget/Program, pursuant to N.J.A.C. 5:31-2, does not confer any authorization to raise or expend funds; rather it is a document to be used as part of the said Authority's planning and management objectives. Specific authorization to expend funds for the purposes described in this section of the budget, must be granted elsewhere; by bond resolution, by a project financing agreement, by resolution appropriating funds from the Renewal and Replacement Reserve or other means provided by law.

October 15, 2012 that the Annual Budget, including appended Supplemental Schedules, and the Capital Budget/Program of the Camden County MUA for the fiscal year beginning, 1/1/2013 and ending, 12/31/2013 is hereby approved; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the anticipated revenues as reflected in the Annual Budget are of sufficient amount to meet all proposed expenditures/expenses and all covenants, terms and provisions as stipulated in the said Authority's outstanding debt obligations, capital lease arrangements, service contracts, and other pledged agreements; and

#### Answers to Questions on Page 3

1. The CCMUA's annual operations and maintenance costs will be level or slightly reduced in 2013, as a result of significant capital improvements to its wastewater treatment plant. However, over the past few years there has been increased debt service associated with those improvements, plus a slower rate of sewer connection fee revenue and additional draws on the CCMUA's surplus, necessitate an increase in the annual rate from \$324 per household to \$338 per household in 2013. It should be noted that the CCMUA's rate in 1996 was \$337 per household. So, the CCMUA has virtually held its rate, in nominal dollars, for the past 17 years and the rate is about 40% lower in real dollars (noting that the value of \$337 in 1996 dollars is well over \$500 in today's dollars) than in 1996. The \$14 per year annual increase equates to little more than \$1 per month.

It should be noted that the CCMUA's 2013 budget includes a \$ 6,135,172 appropriation to Camden County. This Municipal/County Appropriation is divided into two components---- \$3,135,172 is for the annual transfer of 5% of operating costs, assuming sufficient surplus is available, that is statutorily permitted. And, the \$ 3 million balance is for the second and final installment of the road indemnification agreement between the CCMUA and Camden County.

Specifically, the CCMUA is constructing a new 25 mile extension of its regional sewer system, mostly within County roads. Since the County operates a Highway Department, it makes more sense, and would be more cost effective, for the County to take the responsibility for any failures/problems within the portions of County road impacted by the CCMUA's sewer line installation project. Therefore, the CCMUA agreed to pay the County \$5 million in exchange for being indemnified, in perpetuity, for any costs associated with repair of the impacted roads. The CCMUA paid \$2 million to the County in 2012 and will pay the County \$3 million in 2013, thereby completing its financial obligations.

- 2. The proposed increase in the annual rate, from \$324 to \$338 per household, plus the use of the CCMUA's Special Reserve Fund, should increase the CCMUA's overall revenues sufficiently to make up for the anticipated loss in sewer connection fee revenue due to the housing market shrinkage.
- 3. As mentioned above, the housing market shrinkage results in a loss of anticipated sewer connection fee revenue, as well as user fee revenue. However, the CCMUA is not reacting to this problem by reducing its capital expenditures but, instead as discussed above, proposing a modest increase in the annual user fee. In fact, the CCMUA has been extremely proactive in replacing the main capital infrastructure of its wastewater treatment plant in a timely fashion, utilizing the low interest loans offered by the New Jersey Environmental Infrastructure Trust, to keep up with capital requirements while minimizing corresponding debt service requirements.

- 4. The use of unrestricted assets helps CCMUA maintain the user rate. The Authority continues to strive to increase users and find way to save on operations. Also, the Municipal/County Appropriation of \$3,135,172 is for the annual transfer of 5% of operating costs, assuming sufficient surplus is available, that is statutorily permitted.

If not for the loss of sewer connection fee and user fee revenues, due to the shrinking housing market, the CCMUA would have been able to accomplish these capital improvements without raising rates.
