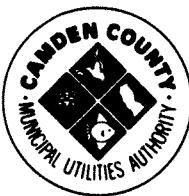

Whereas, the committee determined that JMT's proposal represented the best combination of pricing, expertise and approach; and

Whereas, the cost of the design will be funded through the NJ Environmental Infrastructure Financing Program; and

Whereas, sufficient monies are available and have been certified as being encumbered in accordance with N.J.A.C. 5:30-5.4 per the attached Certification of Available Funds. The line item appropriation of the official budget adopted pursuant to the Local Budget Law which the expenditure will be charged in accordance with the comptroller function is: #0106 0485 0010; and

Whereas, the CCMUA has followed the procedures set forth in the applicable provisions of the New Jersey "Fair and Open" Laws, N.J.S.A. 19:44a-20.4 et seq. in the procurement of this service.

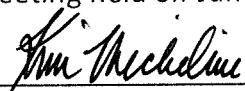

Authorizing Execution of a Memorandum of Agreement with Rutgers University for Continued Implementation of a Green Infrastructure Plan in Camden City

#R-18:6-97

Whereas, the CCMUA has helped to form the Camden City Green Infrastructure Team, comprised of the CCMUA, Camden City, Rutgers, NJ Department of Environmental Protection, NJ Tree Foundation and Cooper's Ferry Development Association, to help reduce the potential of flooding within Camden City and/or discharge of combined sewage to the Delaware River; and

Whereas, the first seven years of the program have been an unqualified success, including the formation of the green infrastructure team, construction of 60 plus rain gardens, design of an additional 20 projects and assisted in securing over \$2,000,000 in grant funds and technical support for such projects; and

Whereas, accordingly, Rutgers has submitted a proposal, in the amount of \$98,000, for the eighth year of the program, which will include design of the additional rain gardens, continued provision of training for green infrastructure maintenance, assistance with the green infrastructure component of the NJDEP required storm water control plan, and pursuit of additional funding for more green infrastructure projects; and

Whereas, the Executive Director highly recommends approval of this agreement for the continuation of this environmentally and socially beneficial program; and

Whereas, sufficient monies are available and have been certified as being encumbered in accordance with N.J.A.C. 5:30-5.4 per the attached Certification of Available Funds. The line item appropriation of the official budget adopted pursuant to the Local Budget Law which the expenditure will be charged in accordance with the comptroller function is #0116 0485 0010.

Now, Therefore Be It Resolved by the CCMUA Board of Commissioners that it authorizes execution of a Memorandum of Agreement with Rutgers University in the amount of \$98,000 for continued implementation of the Camden City Green Infrastructure Plan.

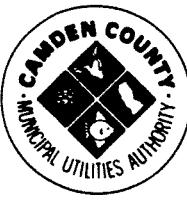

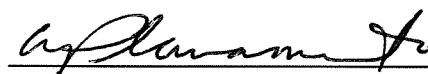

Whereas, the Camden County MUA and the Cooper's Ferry Partnership have been working together on creating new athletic fields in Camden City; and

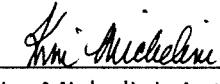
Whereas, these new fields will also include green infrastructure components in order to capture stormwater and thereby reduce combined sewage flooding in Camden; and

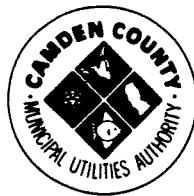

Whereas, the Camden County MUA and the Cooper's Ferry Partnership have been working together on creating new athletic fields in Camden City; and

Whereas, these new fields will also include green infrastructure components in order to capture stormwater and thereby reduce combined sewage flooding in Camden; and

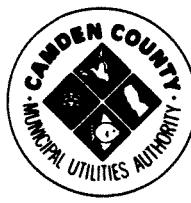
Whereas, the aforementioned stormwater capture will also reduce the wet weather flow directed to the CCMUA's wastewater treatment plant; and

Whereas, accordingly, the CCMUA issued Request for Proposals #2018-11 to procure the necessary design and permitting activities for this project; and

Whereas, the Review Committee was comprised of the CCMUA Executive Director, Andrew Kricun, Kris Kolluri, the Cooper's Ferry CEO, Larry Gaines of Rutgers and James Lex of the Camden County Improvement Authority; and



Whereas, the Request for Proposals had clearly stated that prior relevant experience with the creation of athletic fields, baseball stadiums, etc. would be the most important criterion considered by the Review Committee; and

Whereas, the Review Committee agreed that Ewing Cole, the designer of Citizens Bank Park and other professional stadiums, and PS&S, whose subconsultant had designed Campbell's Field, the site of the new athletic fields in question, clearly had the most relevant experience; and

Whereas, although PS&S had the nominally lower price than Ewing Cole, they also had fewer hours. When the hourly rates were calculated for both firms, Ewing Cole's were slightly lower; and

Whereas, ultimately, the Review Committee determined that Ewing Cole had submitted the proposal with the best combination of prior relevant experience, pricing and approach; and

Whereas, the award of this contract is subject to and conditional upon execution of an agreement between the CCMUA and Cooper's Ferry Partnership which will call for the CCMUA to undertake the design and for Cooper's Ferry to reimburse the CCMUA for the costs of the design; and

Whereas, sufficient monies are available and have been certified as being encumbered in accordance with N.J.A.C. 5:30-5.4 per the attached Certification of Available Funds. The line item appropriation of the official budget adopted pursuant to the Local Budget Law which the expenditure will be charged in accordance with the comptroller function is #0116 0485 0010.

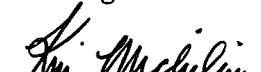

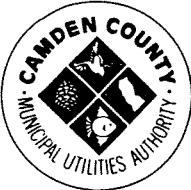

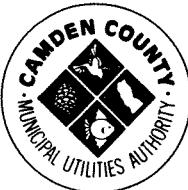
