Whereas, FMP CH Park, LLC (FMP CH Park) has proposed and received approvals for the construction of a residential development located at 202 Park Boulevard, Block 1.01, Lot 3 and Block 3.01, Lot 1 on the tax map of the Township of Cherry Hill, State of New Jersey, commonly known as the "202 Park Boulevard Project";

Whereas, the CCMUA's legal counsel has reviewed a request by FMP CH Park for a reduced connection fee pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40:14B-22.3, and has determined that the 202 Park Boulevard Project contains twenty-nine (29) Affordable Housing Units, which qualify as affordable housing as contemplated under N.J.S.A. 40:14B-22.3; and

Whereas, FMP CH Park has previously acknowledged its willingness to enter into a Contingency Agreement, which shall obligate FMP CH Park to pay the balance of the connection fee reduction contemplated under N.J.S.A. 40:14B-22.3 for the aforementioned twenty-nine (29) Affordable Housing Units, in the event it is determined that, prior to or on the date the parties enter into said Contingency Agreement, the Affordable Housing Units did not qualify as affordable housing and/or for any other reason that would preclude the conditions under N.J.S.A. 40:14B-22.3 from being satisfied; and

Whereas, the calculation of any connection fee(s) in accordance with this Resolution shall be based upon the CCMUA's statutorily authorized connection fee that was in effect on April 15, 2018.

Now, Therefore Be It Resolved, by the CCMUA Board of Commissioners that in accordance with the provisions of N.J.S.A. 40:14B-22.3, the CCMUA is hereby authorized to enter into the aforementioned Contingency Agreement with FMP CH Park; and

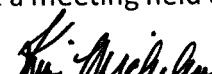

Whereas, therefore, the Executive Director recommends award of a dried byproduct disposal contract with Amerigreen, conditioned upon negotiation of a corresponding amendment to the CCMUA's existing operations and maintenance contract with Synagro.

Whereas, the CCMUA has followed the procedures set forth in the applicable provisions of the New Jersey "Fair and Open" Laws, N.J.S.A. 19:44a et seq. in the procurement of this service; and

Whereas, sufficient monies are available and have been certified as being encumbered in accordance with N.J.A.C. 5:30-5.4 per the attached Certification of Available Funds. #R-19:5-79

WHEREAS, the Open Public Meetings Act, N.J.S.A. 10:4-12, provides that a closed session meeting may be held for certain specified purposes when authorized by Resolution adopted by the governing body; and

WHEREAS, The Camden County Municipal Utilities Authority desires to discuss certain matters relating to the item or items authorized by N.J.S.A. 10:4-12b and designated below:

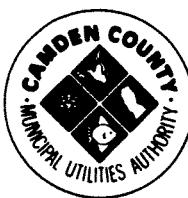
Matters Required by Law to be Confidential: Any matter which, by express provision of Federal Law or Statute or rule of court shall be rendered confidential or excluded from the provisions of the Open Public Meetings Act.

Matters Where the Release of Information Would Impair the Right to Receive Funds: Any matter in which the release of information would impair, restrict or otherwise adversely affect a right to receive funds from the Government of the United States and/or the State of New Jersey.

Matters Involving Individual Privacy: Any material, the disclosure of which constitutes an unwarranted invasion of individual privacy such as any records, data, reports, recommendations, or other personal material of any educational, training, social service, medical, health, custodian, child protection, rehabilitation, legal defense, welfare, housing, relocation, insurance, and similar program or institution operated by a public body pertaining to any specific individual admitted to or served by such institution or program, including pending or anticipated litigation or contract negotiation legal matters, and it desires to do so in Closed Session.

Matters Relating to Collective Bargaining Agreements: Any collective bargaining agreement or the terms and conditions which are proposed for inclusion in any collective bargaining agreement including the negotiation of the terms and conditions thereof with employees or representatives or employees of the public body.

Matters Relating to the Purchase, Lease or Acquisition of Real Property or the Investment of Public Funds: Any matter involving the purchase, lease or acquisition of real property with public funds, the setting of banking rates or investment of public funds, where it could adversely affect the public interest if discussion of such matters were disclosed.



Matters Relating to Public Safety and Property: Any tactics and techniques utilized in protecting the safety and property of the public, provided that their disclosure could impair such protection. Any investigations of violation or possible violations of the law.

Matters Relating to Litigation, Negotiations and the Attorney-Client Privilege: Any pending or anticipated litigation or contract negotiations in which the public body is or may become a party. Any matters falling within the attorney-client privilege, to the extent that confidentiality is required in order for the attorney to exercise his ethical duties as a lawyer.

Matters Relating to the Employment Relationship: Any matter involving the employment, appointment, termination of employment, evaluation of the performance or promotion or disciplining of any specific prospective public officer or employee or current public officer or employee employed or appointed by the public body, unless all the individual employees or appointees whose rights could be adversely affected request in writing that such matter or matters be discussed at a public hearing.

Matters Relating to the Potential Imposition of a Penalty: Any deliberations of a public body occurring after a public hearing or public portion of a meeting that may result in the imposition of a specific civil penalty upon the responding party or the suspension or loss of a license or permit belonging to the responding party.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by The Camden County Municipal Utilities Authority and the members thereof that the Authority shall discuss matters relating to the specific item(s) designated above, and that it does so at a Closed Session Meeting to be held on May 20, 2019, at the Authority offices located at 1645 Ferry Avenue, Camden, New Jersey, and that minutes of the Closed Session Meeting shall be kept, as required by the Open Public Meetings Law, and the Authority is authorized to take whatever action it deems advisable or necessary at said Closed Session Meeting, and the matters discussed and actions taken at such meeting shall be disclosed to the public as soon thereafter as can conveniently be done.
