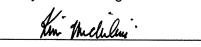

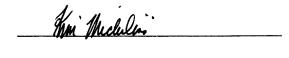

Matters Where the Release of Information Would Impair the Right to Receive Funds: Any matter in which the release of information would impair, restrict or otherwise adversely affect a right to receive funds from the Government of the United States and/or the State of New Jersey. Matters Involving Individual Privacy: Any material, the disclosure of which constitutes an unwarranted invasion of individual privacy such as any records, data, reports, recommendations, or other personal material of any educational, training, social service, medical, health, custodian, child protection, rehabilitation, legal defense, welfare, housing, relocation, insurance, and similar program or institution operated by a public body pertaining to any specific individual admitted to or served by such institution or program, including pending or anticipated litigation or contract negotiation legal matters, and it desires to do so in Closed Session.
